Lan Zhang serves as Deputy General Manager of C3's organization in Shanghai, China. His focus is on Project Delivery, and understands sustainable design and construction practices. Lan Zhang has served as Project Manager for C3's strategic clients, such as SanDisk (semiconductor assembly/test facility, 34,000m²), Milliken (Floor Covering Division retrofit project, 10,000 m²), and Applied Materials (Global Solar R&D Center, 40,000m².)
